## Colors of Cleanliness, A Future Together



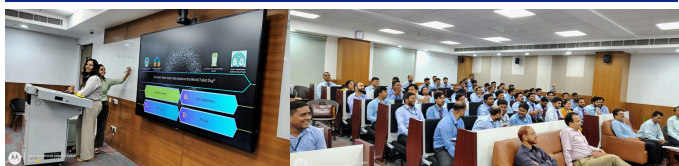
