Ref: Your appeal dated 15-04-2016 receieved in this office on 28-04-2016 and subsequent appeal on 07-05-2016 received in this office on 17-05-2016.

You above referred appeals have been considered by the undersigned. The points appealed against vis-à-vis the replies available on your appeals from the custodian of information have been gone through and are observed as under;

As per record in the year 2016 you have sought for information under the RTI Act. as many as 09 times and in all cases, barring the latest ones you have been provided with replies whatever available with the Public Authority. The PIO of this office provides you with information what is available with the Public Authority. He can't create information on his own neither there is any scope for him to construct false information with the objective of confusing the RTI applicants.

Secondly, most of your applications/appeals are received through Railway Board(Ministry of Railways) and since the project offices are situated all over the country and the information which you had sought for was pertaining to third party associated with one of such project offices obtaining information and supplying those takes time thus resulting in minor delays. In this case, however, you have been advised of the interim positions vide my letters dated 23-05-2016

and 17-06-2016.

So far as your appeal is concerned the same is disposed of as

under:

In respect of points No.1 and 2, I found that the the custodian of information i.e, the CPM/Tundla's office has always been maintatining the position that the inspection reports available with them or with the SAI-TYPSA are open to your scrutiny or inspection. At any point of time as per your convenience and with early information to offices concerned you can isit and inspect the papers/reports available.

In respect of point No.3 the reply given earlier by the PIO still

iolds good.

I hope you will appreciate the position.
