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Section I. Instructions to Applicants

A. General

1. Scope of Application

1.1 In connection with the Invitation for Prequalification¹ indicated in Section II, Prequalification Data Sheet (PDS), the Employer, as defined in the **PDS**, issues this Prequalification Document ("Prequalification Document") to prospective applicants ("Applicants") interested in submitting applications ("Applications") for prequalification to bid for the Works described in Section VII, Scope of Works. In case the Works are to be bid as individual contracts (i.e. the slice and package procedure), these are listed in the PDS. The International Competitive Bidding ("ICB") number corresponding to this prequalification is also provided in the **PDS**.

2. Source of Funds

2.1 The Borrower or Recipient (hereinafter called "Borrower") indicated in the PDS has applied for or received financing (hereinafter called "funds") from the International Bank for Reconstruction and International Development Association Development or the (hereinafter called "the Bank") towards the cost of the project named in the **PDS**. The Borrower intends to apply a portion of the funds to eligible payments under the contract(s) resulting from the bidding for which this prequalification is conducted. Payment by the Bank will be made only at the request of the Borrower and upon approval by the Bank, and will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the loan (or financing) agreement. The loan (or financing) agreement prohibits a withdrawal from the loan (or credit) account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of the Bank, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than the Borrower shall derive any rights from the loan (or financing) agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the loan (or credit).

3. Corrupt and Fraudulent Practices

- 3.1 The Bank requires compliance with its policy in regard to corrupt and fraudulent practices as set forth in Section VI.
- 3.2 In further pursuance of this policy, Applicants shall permit and shall cause its agents to permit the Bank to inspect all accounts, records and other documents relating to the submission of the Application,

The Invitation for Prequalification (IFP) provided information for potential bidders to decide whether to participate, including the essential items listed in the Standard Prequalification Document and also any important or specialized prequalification requirements requested to qualify for the prequalification.

bid submission (in case prequalified), and contract performance (in the case of award), and to have them audited by auditors appointed by the Bank.

4. Eligible Applicants

- 4.1 Applicants shall meet the eligibility criteria as per clause 5.1. For the purpose of applying the eligibility criteria listed in this Clause 4 and 5, references to the "Applicant" include all entities involved or intended to be involved with the proposed Works (including all partners and any of their affiliates that directly or indirectly control, or are controlled by or are under common control with the firm), specialized sub-contractors, consultants, manufacturers or suppliers (as mentioned in Form ELI-1.2 Applicant's Party Information Form), and the personnel of each, for any part of the contract including related services.
- 4.2 An Applicant may be a firm that is a private entity, a government-owned entity—subject to ITA 4.9 or a combination of such entities in the form of a joint venture ("JV") under an existing agreement or with the intent to enter into such an agreement supported by a letter of intent. In the case of a JV, all members shall be jointly and severally liable for the execution of the Contract in accordance with the Contract terms. The JV shall nominate an authorized representative who shall have the authority to conduct all business for and on behalf of any and all the members of the JV during the prequalification process, bidding (in the event the JV submits a bid) and during contract execution (in the event the JV is awarded the Contract). Unless specified in the PDS, there is no limit on the number of members in a JV.
- 4.3 A firm may apply for prequalification both individually, and as part of a joint venture, or as a sub-contractor. If prequalified, it will not be permitted to bid for the same contract both as an individual firm and as a part of the joint venture or as a sub-contractor. However, a firm may participate as a sub-contractor in more than one bid, but only in that capacity. Bids submitted in violation of this procedure will be rejected.
- 4.4 A firm and any of its affiliates (that directly or indirectly control, are controlled by or are under common control with that firm) may submit its application for prequalification either individually, as joint venture or as a sub-contractor among them for the same contract. However, if prequalified only one prequalified applicant will be allowed to bid for the same contract. All bids submitted in violation of this procedure will be rejected.
- 4.5 An Applicant may have the nationality of any country, subject to the

restrictions pursuant to ITA 5.1. An Applicant shall be deemed to have the nationality of a country if the Applicant is constituted, incorporated or registered in and operates in conformity with the provisions of the laws of that country, as evidenced by its articles of incorporation (or equivalent documents of constitution or association) and its registration documents, as the case may be. This criterion also shall apply to the determination of the nationality of proposed specialized sub-contractors or suppliers for any part of the Contract including related Services.

- 4.6 Applicants shall not have a conflict of interest. Applicants shall be considered to have a conflict of interest, if they participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications or have been hired or proposed to be hired by the Employer or Borrower as Engineer for contract implementation of the works that are the subject of this prequalification.
- 4.7 An Applicant that has been sanctioned by the Bank in accordance with the above ITA 3.1, including in accordance with the Bank's Guidelines on Preventing and Combating Corruption in Projects Financed by IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and Grants ("Anti-Corruption Guidelines"), shall be ineligible to be prequalified, to bid for, awarded a Bank-financed contract or benefit from a Bank-financed contract, financially or otherwise, during such period of time as the Bank shall have determined.
- 4.8 The list of debarred firms and individuals is available at the electronic address specified in the **PDS**.
- 4.9 Government-owned enterprises or institutions in the Employer's Country may participate only if they can establish that they (i) are legally and financially autonomous (ii) operate under commercial law, and (iii) are not dependent agencies of the Employer². To be eligible, a government-owned enterprise or institution shall establish to the Bank's satisfaction, through all relevant documents, including its Charter and other information the Bank may request, that it: (i) is a legal entity separate from the government (ii) does not currently receive substantial subsidies or budget support; (iii) operates like any commercial enterprise, and, inter alia, is not obliged to pass on its surplus to the government, can acquire rights and liabilities, borrow funds and be liable for repayment of its debts, and can be declared bankrupt; and (iv) is not bidding for a contract to be awarded by the department or agency of the government which under their applicable

laws or regulations is the reporting or supervisory authority of the enterprise or has the ability to exercise influence or control over the enterprise or institution.

- 4.10 An Applicant shall not be under suspension from bidding by the Employer as the result of the execution of a Bid–Securing Declaration.
- 4.11 An Applicant shall provide such evidence of eligibility satisfactory to the Employer, as the Employer shall reasonably request.

5. Eligibility

5.1 Firms and individuals may be ineligible if they are nationals of ineligible countries as indicated in Section V. The countries, persons or entities are ineligible if (a) as a matter of law or official regulations, the Borrower's country prohibits commercial relations with that country, provided that the Bank is satisfied that such exclusion does not preclude effective competition for the supply of goods or the contracting of works or services required; or (b) by an act of compliance with a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations, the Borrower's country prohibits any import of goods or contracting of works or services from that country, or any payments to any country, person, or entity in that country.

B. Contents of the Prequalification Document

6. Sections of Prequalification Document

6.1 This Prequalification Document consists of parts 1 and 2 which comprise all the sections indicated below, and which should be read in conjunction with any Addendum issued in accordance with ITA 8.

- 6.2 Unless obtained directly from the Employer, the Employer accepts no responsibility for the completeness of the document, responses to

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requests for clarification, the minutes of the pre-Application meeting (if any), or Addenda to the Prequalification Document in accordance with ITA 8. In case of any discrepancies, documents issued directly by the Employer shall prevail.

- 6.3 The Applicant is expected to examine all instructions, forms, and terms in the Prequalification Document and to furnish with its Application all information or documentation as is required by the Prequalification Document.
- 7. Clarification of Prequalification Document and Pre-Application Meeting
- any clarification of 7.1 Applicant requiring the A prospective Pregualification Document shall contact the Employer in writing at the Employer's address indicated in the PDS. The Employer will respond in writing to any request for clarification provided that such request is received no later than fourteen (14) days prior to the deadline for submission of the applications. The Employer shall forward a copy of its response to all prospective Applicants who have obtained the Pregualification Document directly from the Employer, including a description of the inquiry but without identifying its source. If so indicated in the PDS, the Employer shall also promptly publish its response at the web page identified in the PDS. Should the Employer deem it necessary to amend the Prequalification Document as a result of a clarification, it shall do so following the procedure under ITA 8 and in accordance with the provisions of ITA 17.2.
- 7.2 If indicated in the PDS, the prospective Applicant's designated representative is invited at the Applicant's cost to attend a pre-Application meeting at the place, date and time mentioned in the PDS. During this pre-Application meeting, prospective Applicants may request clarification of the project requirement, the criteria for qualifications or any other aspects of the Prequalification Document.
- Minutes of the pre-Application meeting, if applicable, including the 7.3 text of the questions asked by Applicants, including those during the meeting (without identifying the source) and the responses given, together with any responses prepared after the meeting will be transmitted promptly to all prospective Applicants who have obtained Prequalification the Document. Any modification Prequalification Document that may become necessary as a result of the pre-Application meeting shall be made by the Employer exclusively through the use of an Addendum pursuant to ITA 8. Nonattendance at the pre-Application meeting will not be a cause for disqualification of an Applicant.

8. Amendment of Prequalification Document

- 8.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of Applications, the Employer may amend the Prequalification Document by issuing an Addendum.
- 8.2 Any Addendum issued shall be part of the Prequalification Document and shall be communicated in writing to all prospective Applicants who have obtained the Prequalification Document from the Employer. The Employer shall promptly publish the Addendum at the Employer's web page identified in the **PDS**.
- 8.3 To give prospective Applicants reasonable time to take an Addendum into account in preparing their Applications, the Employer may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of Applications in accordance with ITA 17.2.

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C. Preparation of Applications

9. Cost of Applications

9.1 The Applicant shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Application. The Employer will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the prequalification process.

10. Language of Application

10.1 The Application as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the prequalification exchanged by the Applicant and the Employer, shall be written in the language specified in the PDS. Supporting documents and printed literature that are part of the Application may be in another language, provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in the language specified in the PDS, in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the Application, the translation shall govern.

11. Documents Comprising the Application

11.1 The Application shall comprise the following:

- (a) Application Submission Form, in accordance with ITA 12.1;
- (b) documentary evidence establishing the Applicant's eligibility, in accordance with ITA 13.1;
- (c) documentary evidence establishing the Applicant's qualifications, in accordance with ITA 14; and
- (d) any other document required as specified in the PDS.
- 11.2 The Applicant shall furnish information on commissions and gratuities, if any, paid or to be paid to agents or any other party relating to this Application

12. Application Submission Form

12.1 The Applicant shall complete an Application Submission Form as provided in Section IV, Application Forms. This Form must be completed without any alteration to its format.

13. Documents Establishing the Eligibility of the Applicant

- 13.1 To establish its eligibility in accordance with ITA 4, the Applicant shall complete the eligibility declarations in the Application Submission Form and Forms ELI (eligibility) 1.1 and 1.2, included in Section IV (Application Forms).
- 14. Documents
 Establishing
 the
 Qualifications
 of the Applicant
- 14.1 To establish its qualifications to perform the contract(s) in accordance with Section III, Qualification Criteria and Requirements, the Applicant shall provide the information requested in the corresponding Information Sheets included in Section IV, Application Forms.

14.2 Wherever an Application Form requires an Applicant to state a monetary amount, Applicants should indicate the USD equivalent using the rate of exchange determined as follows:

For construction turnover or financial data required for each year -Exchange rate prevailing on the last day of the respective Financial year (in which the amounts for that year is to be converted) was originally established.

Value of single contract - Exchange rate prevailing on the date of the contract.

Exchange rates shall be taken from the publicly available source identified in the **PDS**. Any error in determining the exchange rates in the Application may be corrected by the Employer.

15. Signing of the Application and Number of Copies

- 15.1 The Applicant shall prepare one original of the documents comprising the Application as described in ITA 11 and clearly mark it "ORIGINAL". The original of the Application shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person duly authorized to sign on behalf of the Applicant. In case the Applicant is a JV, the Application shall be signed by an authorized representative of the JV on behalf of the JV and so as to be legally binding on all the members as evidenced by a power of attorney signed by their legally authorized signatories.
- 15.2 The Applicant shall submit copies of the signed original Application, in the number specified in the PDS, and clearly mark them "COPY". In the event of any discrepancy between the original and the copies, the original shall prevail.

D. Submission of Applications

16. Sealing and Identification of Applications

- 16.1 The Applicant shall enclose the original and the copies of the Application in a sealed envelope that shall:
 - (a) bear the name and address of the Applicant;
 - (b) be addressed to the Employer, in accordance with ITA 17.1; and
 - (c) bear the specific identification of this prequalification process indicated in the PDS 1.1.
- 16.2 The Employer will accept no responsibility for not processing any envelope that was not identified as required in ITA 16.1 above.

17. Deadline for Submission of

17.1 Applicants may either submit their Applications by mail or by hand. Applications shall be received by the Employer at the address and no later than the deadline indicated in the **PDS.** When so specified

Applications

in the **PDS**, Applicants have the option of submitting their Applications electronically, in accordance with electronic application submission procedures specified in the **PDS**.

17.2 The Employer may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of Applications by amending the Prequalification Document in accordance with ITA 8, in which case all rights and obligations of the Employer and the Applicants subject to the previous deadline shall thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

18. Late Applications

18.1 The Employer reserves the right to accept applications received after the deadline for submission of applications, unless otherwise specified in the **PDS**.

19. Opening of Applications

- 19.1 The Employer shall open all Applications at the date, time and place specified in the PDS. Late Applications shall be treated in accordance with ITA 18.1.
- 19.2 Applications submitted electronically (if permitted pursuant to ITA 17.1) shall be opened in accordance with the procedures specified in the PDS.
- 19.3 The Employer shall prepare a record of the opening of Applications to include, as a minimum, the name of the Applicants. A copy of the record shall be distributed to all Applicants.

E. Procedures for Evaluation of Applications

20. Confidentiality

- 20.1 Information relating to the Applications, their evaluation and result shall not be disclosed to Applicants or any other persons not officially concerned with the prequalification process until the notification of prequalification results is made to all Applicants in accordance with ITA 28.
- 20.2 From the deadline for submission of Applications to the time of notification of the results of the prequalification in accordance with ITA 28, any Applicant that wishes to contact the Employer on any matter related to the prequalification process (except as specified in 20.1 above), may do so only in writing.

21. Clarification of Applications

21.1 To assist in the evaluation of Applications, the Employer may, at its discretion, ask an Applicant for a clarification (including missing documents) of its Application, to be submitted within a stated reasonable period of time. Any request for clarification from the

Employer and all clarifications from the Applicant shall be in writing.

21.2 If an Applicant does not provide clarifications and/or documents requested by the date and time set in the Employer's request for clarification, its Application shall be evaluated based on the information and documents available at the time of evaluation of the Application.

22. Responsiveness of Applications

- 22.1 The Employer may reject any Application which is not responsive to the requirements of the Prequalification Document. In case the information furnished by the Applicant is incomplete or otherwise requires clarification as per ITA 21.1, and the Applicant fails to provide satisfactory clarification and/or missing information, it may result in disqualification of the Applicant.
- 23. Domestic

 Bidder Price

 Preference
- 23.1 Unless otherwise specified in the **PDS**, a margin of preference for domestic bidders³ shall not apply in the bidding process resulting from this prequalification.
- 24. Sub-contractors
- 24.1 Unless otherwise stated in the **PDS**, the Employer does not intend to execute any specific elements of the Works by sub-contractors selected in advance by the Employer.
- 24.2 The Employer may decide to permit subcontracting for certain specialized works as indicated in Section III 4.2, Experience. The Employer may do so at its own initiative or at the request of the Applicants during the prequalification process (if justified). When subcontracting is permitted by the Employer, the specialized subcontractors experience shall be considered for evaluation. Section III describes the qualification criteria for sub-contractors.
- 24.3 Applicants may propose subcontracting to the percentage of the total value of the contract or the volume of works mentioned in the **PDS** and as further described in ITA 25.2.

F. Evaluation of Applications and Prequalification of Applicants

25. Evaluation of

25.1 The Employer shall use the factors, methods, criteria, and

³An individual firm is considered a domestic bidder for purposes of the margin of preference if it is registered in the country of the Employer, has more than 50 percent ownership by nationals of the country of the Employer, and if it does not subcontract more than 10 percent of the contract price, excluding provisional sums, to foreign contractors. JVs are considered as domestic bidders and eligible for domestic preference only if the individual member firms are registered in the country of the Employer, have more than 50 percent ownership by nationals of the country of the Employer, and the JV shall be registered in the country of the Borrower. The JV shall not subcontract more than 10 percent of the contract price, excluding provisional sums, to foreign firms. JVs between foreign and national firms will not be eligible for domestic preference.

requirements defined in Section III, Qualification Criteria and Requirements, to evaluate the qualifications of the Applicants, and no other methods, criteria, or requirements shall be used. The Employer reserves the right to waive minor deviations from the qualification criteria if they do not materially affect the technical capability and financial resources of an Applicant to perform the contract.

- 25.2 Applicants planning to subcontract more than 10% of total volume of work shall specify, in the Application Submission Form, the activity (ies) or parts of the works to be subcontracted along with complete details of the sub-contractors and their qualification and experience. The sub-contractors proposed shall be fully qualified for their work proposed, and meet the specified criteria in Section III, failing which such sub-contractors will not be permitted to participate. The qualification and experience of sub-contractors proposed by the Applicant under ITA 24.3 will not be considered for evaluation of the Applicant. The Applicant on its own (without taking into account the qualification and experience of the sub-contractor) should meet the prequalification criteria.
- 25.3 In case of multiple contracts, Applicants should indicate in their Applications the individual contract or combination of contracts in which they are interested. The Employer shall prequalify each Applicant for the maximum combination of contracts for which the Applicant has thereby indicated its interest and for which the Applicant meets the appropriate aggregate requirements. The Qualification Criteria and Requirements are mentioned in Section III. However, with respect to the specific experience under item 4.2 (a) of Section III, the Employer will select any one or more of the options as identified below:

N is the minimum number of contracts

V is the minimum value of a single contract

- (iii) Subject to compliance as per (ii) above with respect to minimum value of single contract for each lot, total number of contracts is equal or less than N1 + N2 + N3 +--but the total value of all such contracts is equal or more than N1 x V1 + N2 x V2 + N3 x V3 +---.
- 25.4 Only the qualifications of the Applicant shall be considered. In particular, the qualifications of a parent or other affiliated company that is not party to the Applicant under a JV in accordance with ITA 4.2 (or participating as a sub-contractor as per ITA 25.2) shall not be considered.
- 26. Employer's
 Right to Accept
 or Reject
 Applications
- 26.1 The Employer reserves the right to accept or reject any Application, and to annul the prequalification process and reject all Applications at any time, without thereby incurring any liability to the Applicants.
- 27. Prequalification of Applicants
- 27.1 All Applicants who's Applications substantially meet or exceed the specified qualification requirements will be prequalified by the Employer.

- 27.2 An Applicant may be "conditionally prequalified," that is, qualified subject to the Applicant submitting or correcting certain specified nonmaterial documents or deficiencies to the satisfaction of the Employer.
- 27.3 Applicants that are conditionally prequalified will be so informed along with the statement of the condition(s) which must be met to the satisfaction of the Employer before or at the time of submitting their bids.

28. Notification of Prequalification

- 28.1 The Employer shall notify all Applicants in writing of the names of those Applicants who have been prequalified or conditionally prequalified. In addition, those Applicants who have been disqualified will be informed separately.
- 28.2 Applicants that have not been prequalified may write to the Employer to request, in writing, the grounds on which they were disqualified.

29. Invitation for Bids

- 29.1 Promptly after the notification of the results of the prequalification, the Employer shall invite bids from all the Applicants that have been prequalified or conditionally prequalified.
- 29.2 Bidders may be required to provide a Bid Security or a Bid-Securing Declaration acceptable to the Employer in the form and an amount to be specified in the Bidding Documents, and the successful Bidder shall be required to provide a Performance Security as specified in the Bidding Documents.

30. Changes in Qualifications of Applicants

30.1 Any change in the structure or formation of an Applicant after being prequalified in accordance with ITA 27 and invited to bid (including, in the case of a JV, any change in the structure or formation of any member thereto) shall be subject to the written approval of the Employer prior to the deadline for submission of bids. - (c) will declare misprocurement and cancel the portion of the loan allocated to a contract if it determines at any time that representatives of the Borrower or of a recipient of any part of the proceeds of the loan engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, or obstructive practices during the procurement or the implementation of the contract in question, without the Borrower having taken timely and appropriate action satisfactory to the Bank to address such practices when they occur, including by failing to inform the Bank in a timely manner at the time they knew of the practices;

PART 2 – Works Requirements

Section VII. Scope of Works

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1. Description of Works

1.1 General

1.1.1 The Dedicated Freight Corridor (DFC) Project:

Ministry of Railways (MOR), Government of India has planned to construct Dedicated High Axle Load Freight Corridor covering about 3363 kms on two corridors, Eastern Corridor from Ludhiana (Sahnewal) to Dankuni and Western Corridor from Jawaharlal Nehru Port, Mumbai to Tughlakabad/ Dadri near Delhi along with inter-linking of the two corridors at Dadri.

The DFC Project entails construction of mostly double line railway tracks except single line between Khurja – Sahnewal (near Ludhiana). Up-gradation of transportation technology, increase in productivity and reduction in unit transportation costs have been taken as guiding principles for formulating the DFC project. Various operating systems, motive power, signalling and work processes are required to conform to this broad perspective.

1.2 Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India Limited

1.2.1 Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India Ltd. (DFCC), a public sector company has been set up under the Indian Companies Act 1956 for implementation of Dedicated Freight Corridor Project. Government of India is the sole shareholder of the DFCC.

1.3 Eastern Dedicated Freight Corridor Alignment

- 1.3.1 Eastern DFC Route will be approximately 1847 Km long from Dankuni to Ludhiana via Mughalsarai Allahabad Kanpur Tundla Aligarh and Khurja. Proposed alignment of DFC has been generally kept parallel to existing Indian Railway line except provision of detours at Mughalsarai, Mirzapur, Manda Road, Allahabad, Bharwari, Sirathu, Khaga, Fatehpur, Kanpur, Etawah, Tundla, Hathras, Aligarh, Hapur, Meerut/Muzaffarnagar, and Ambala.
- 1.3.2 The Eastern Dedicated Freight Corridor (EDFC) alignment passes through six States viz. West Bengal, Jharkhand, Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Haryana and Punjab. It traverses Howrah, Hoogly, Bardhman districts in West Bengal and Gaya, Aurangabad, Rohtas (Sasaram) and Kaimur (Bhabua) districts in Bihar, Chandauli, Varanasi, Mirzapur, Allahabad, Kausambi, Fatehpur, Kanpur (Urban), Kanpur (Rural), Auraiya, Etawah, Ferozabad, Agra, Hathras, Aligarh, Bulandsahr, Ghaziabad, Gautambudhnagar, Meerut, Muzaffar Nagar, Saharanpur districts in Uttar Pradesh, Yamuna Nagar, Ambala districts in Haryana and Patiala, Fatehgarh Sahib, Ludhiana districts in Punjab.

1.4 Project Phasing

The project is planned in a phased manner. The first phase of the Project covers a length of 343 km from Bhaupur to Khurja-all double line.

The second phase (Phase-2) covers a length of 402 route km between Mughalsarai – New Bhaupur section double-line, 2x25 KV Electrified section with Automatic Block Signaling.

Phase 3 consists of about 404 Km single line, Khurja – Sahnewal (near Ludhiana), 2x25 Kv electrified, signalling with absolute block working. Eastern and Western Corridors of DFCC are connected to each other through a 46 Km double line link between Khurja and Dadri. It will also be, 2x25 KV Electrified section with Automatic Block Signaling. This link is also a part of Phase-3 of Eastern Corridor.

1.5 Funding of the Project

1.5.1 Eastern DFC Project for 1183 Km including Phase 2 and 3 is to be funded by World Bank and for Phase-1 of Eastern DFC i.e. Khurja –Bhaupur Section, loan has already been sanctioned by World Bank vide Loan No. 8066 –IN.

1.6 Alignment of Sahnewal-Pilkhani and Dadri-Khurja Sections

1.6.1 The alignment of Sahnewal-Pilkhani (175 km) single line section (175 km) mostly runs parallel to the existing IR track except for a length of approximately 18 km which is covered through 3 (three) detours at Ambala Cantt, Shambhu and Sirhind.

The alignment of Dadri-Khurja connecting the Eastern and Western Corridors is a double line section with an approximate length of 46 km and runs parallel to the existing IR track except for a detour at Wair with an approximate length of 5 km.

1.6.2 Grade separators are planned over existing Indian Railway tracks for uninterrupted flow of traffic of both Indian Railways (IR) traffic and DFCC at Ambala, Shambhu and Sirhind.

Sketches showing the alignments are attached as Annexure I and II.

1.7 Present Status of Phase 3

1.7.1 Presently, the process of land acquisition between Sahnewal – Pilkhani (approximately 175 kms of single line) and Dadri – Khurja Section (46 kms of double line) is nearing completion. The Social Impact Assessment and Environment Impact Assessment studies for this section have also been completed. A portion of alignment falling in detours between Pilkhani – Khurja Section (approximately 229 km of single line) has been modified recently because of various constraints. While land acquisition of original alignment (other than

detours) has been completed, the process of land acquisition for modified alignment on detours of Phase 3 is likely to take some more time. The present prequalification document is only for the Civil, Structures and Track Works of the following sections:

- Sahnewal Pilkhani (approximately 175 kms of single line) Contract Package 301
- 2. Dadri Khurja Section (46 kms of double line) Contract Package 302

The current Prequalification exercise is to identify suitable Bidders for the two Civil, Structures and Track Works Contracts designated as Contract 301 and Contract 302.

The detailed scope of the work is described below:

1.8 Scope of Works

Scope of Work as included in this document is indicative. Detailed Scope of Work will be included in the Bid documents to be issued to pre-qualified bidders.

- a) The Contractor shall undertake the design, construction, manufacture, supply, installation, testing and commissioning of the Civil, Structure, and Track works including construction of staff quarters, station buildings, rest houses, allied service buildings etc., the design, construction and removal of any Temporary Works and diversions of utility services both of IR and other impacted authorities as included in Employer's Requirement of Bid Document.
- b) In addition, the Contractor shall undertake the rectification of defects appearing in the Permanent Works in the manner and to the standards within the time stipulated by the Contract.
- c) In full recognition of these objectives and with full acceptance of the obligations, the Contractor shall execute the Works taking into account all liabilities and risks that may be involved.
- d) The system design and its installation will be carried out by OHE Contractor &Signalling Contractor and includes electrification of the line, new signalling and control systems, new telecommunication system, SCADA control system. As such, these works are excluded from the scope of this document.
- e) The design of all the works will be operationally compatible with the other Indian Railways (IR) sections connecting to the DFC.
- f) The Employer may decide to take over the constructed sections from the Contractor in a phased manner as per mutually agreed handing over plan.

g) The Civil, structure and Track Works Contractor shall undertake interface co-ordination with the OHE Contractor & Signalling Contractors, who shall be carrying out works forming part of this Project. There will be a continuous requirement of coordination among the Contractors in respect of, but not limited to, design of cable trenching, masts for overhead electrification, interlocking of points and crossings, construction of facilities for maintenance, other allied structures and subsequently during the installation of signalling and traction power systems.

1.9 Permanent Works

- 1.9.1 The permanent works shall comprise of but not limited to the design, construction, manufacture, supply, installation, testing and commissioning of:
 - a) Track substructure including drainage, embankments, cuttings, blanketing, ballast, bridges (Important/major/minor), underpasses, rail flyovers etc.
 - b) Track superstructure including but not limited to setting out, benchmarking, rail and sleepers with fastenings, rail slab where necessary, turnouts, buffer stops, expansion joints, track signage, etc.
 - c) Road overpasses and underpasses including approach roads, substructures, surfacing, drainage facilities, guardrails etc.;
 - d) Road modifications for the roads affected by the railway line and relevant facilities;
 - e) Remodelling of Level Crossing Gates and duty hut of Existing Indian Railways Network located on DFCC alignment;
 - f) Platforms including drainage, fencing, pavement.
 - g) Yard complexes including fencing, drainage, sewerage, craneage, and safety equipment;
 - h) On-duty points for maintenance staff including fencing, buildings, drainage, sewerage, offices, stores, craneage, lighting, E&M services and car parking, office equipment and furniture, kitchenware, bathrooms, beds etc., installation and safety equipment;
 - i) Noise barriers in urban areas;
 - j) Fencing at stations;
 - k) Utility diversions as applicable; and
 - 1) Any other activity connected with the construction and commissioning of railways.

8 Track Construction

Track Construction would be done to suit train speed up to 100 kmph. The track would consist of the main lines, loops, sidings and would involve laying of turnouts, switch expansion joints, the rail insulated joints, dead ends protected by buffer stops.

Specialized track construction would be required at level crossings.

The loops in general would be having a length of 750m/1500m. The track construction would be required to be done for bulk of the length in the vicinity of Indian Railway Tracks carrying a very high density of freight and passenger carrying trains. As such the construction of the proposed DFC tracks would be required to be done to cause least interference to the movement of Indian Railway Traffic.

The DFC track would be required to be integrated with Indian Railway track at nominated junction stations.

^{*}The bank width would be suitably increased to cater for the increased ballast cushion on the outside of curve for the cant of the curve.

^{**} The turnouts in the IR yards at the junction stations will be as per approved IR designs.

1.11 Technical Standards and Specifications

- 1.11.1 The general designs are based on Codes of Practice prescribed by the Indian Railways, Bureau of Indian Standards, and Indian Roads Congress etc. Where the standards and specifications are not available in the Indian Codes of Practice, International Codes of Practice/Specifications to be adopted with the approval of DFCC. Detailed specifications would be provided in the bidding documents.
- 1.11.2 Research Design and Standards Organization (RDSO), Lucknow, India, an organization of Ministry of Railways, Government of India has standardized the technical specifications for various components of railway systems in India as Indian Railway Standard (IRS) Specifications, which are generally based on International Specifications and adopted to Indian conditions. The list of IRS Specifications issued by RDSO is available at the website of RDSO (www.rdso.gov.in). The IRS Specifications can be purchased from RDSO.
- 1.11.3 The Employer's requirements would be spelt out in the bidding document and would be in general conformity to the IRS Specifications.
- 1.11.4 RDSO maintains approved list of suppliers/vendors for various equipment/items/components to be used on Railway systems in India. Bidders shall be free to obtain equipment/items from the suppliers/vendors on approved list of RDSO or any other sources provided the equipment/item meets the technical requirements/acceptance criteria which will be indicated in the Bidding document.
- 1.11.5 The list of suppliers/vendors approved for various items are available at the website of RDSO (www.rdso.gov.in). Procedures for registration of the new suppliers/vendors for railway equipment/items are also available at the website of RDSO. The bidders are advised to visit the website of RDSO for further information about the registration of new products.

1.12 Project Implementation

- 1.12.1 The Project involves Design of Alignment, Track, Formation, Bridges & Structures including Flyovers/ROB/RUB followed by Construction, Integrated Testing and Commissioning and integration with existing IR System and remedying the defects in the Works during the defect liability period. The indicative parameters, axle load and speed potential of the proposed construction are defined in Para 1.10.1 above.
- 1.12.2 As a part of the Bid Documents, the Pre-qualified Bidders will be provided with Employers Requirements, Concept Design, Performance Specifications and other available indicated field data e.g. (i) Alignment Survey, (ii) Geotechnical (iii) Hydrological Calculations for Discharge/HFL of Bridges.

The field data provided as a part of the Bid Documents by the Employer is based on the investigation carried out by the Employer and is for reference purposes only. The Bidder will have to satisfy himself with the field data furnished and make his own investigations, if required, for submitting his offer. The Bidder shall be deemed to have obtained all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and all other circumstances which may influence or affect his Bid. Costs associated with any change in design or construction methodology later during execution on account of any change will be borne by the Contractor.

- 1.12.3 The Employer's Requirements/Performance Specifications provided as a part of the Bid Documents, specify the procedural requirements for the preparation of the design of the Permanent and Temporary Works.
- 1.12.4 The Contractor shall engage the Designer who will undertake and prepare the Design of the Permanent Works and Temporary Works. The principal requirements of the Design Phase are the production of the Preliminary Design, the Definitive Design and the Construction Reference Drawings.
 - a) The Preliminary Design shall incorporate the Contractor's tender design developed to sufficiently define the main formation, permanent way, bridges including Flyovers/ROB/RUB and other structures. Upon approval by the Engineer, the Contractor shall, proceed to prepare the definitive Designs.
- 1.12.5 The Definitive Design shall incorporate the Contractor's Technical Proposals and shall be the design developed to the stage at which all elements of permanent way, structures including bridges are fully defined and specified. During the preparation of the Definitive Design, the Contractor shall complete all surveys, investigations and testing necessary to complete the design of the Permanent Works.
- 1.12.6 Upon issuance of the approval, or a deficiencies list, by the Engineer in respect of the Definitive Design Submission, normally within the period stated in the Contract, the Contractor shall complete the design in all respects and produce the Construction Reference Drawings, the purpose of which is to illustrate all the Permanent Works and to be the drawings governing construction.

The detailed procedure for the design submissions shall be described in the Bidding Document.

1.13 Utilities

1.13.1 The utilities have generally been identified as part of the field data collected by the Employer. However, there is always a possibility of some the unidentified utilities being detected by the Contractor during the course of data collection or during the construction. Chartered utilities will be detailed in the Bid Document, the diversion of which shall be the responsibility of the Contractor. However, the Contractor shall be responsible to remove all the Chartered and unchartered

utilities. Removal of unchartered utilities will be treated as a variation.

1.14 Interfacing with System Contractor

1.14.1 The Civil, Structures and Track Works (CST) Contractor(s) appointed through this PQ exercise followed by the Two Stage Bidding process shall be required to interface, coordinate and cooperate with the project wide Electrical Contractors and Signalling & Telecommunication Contractors engaged to execute the Signalling, Telecommunications, Electrification, OHE and SCADA Works in such a way that complete Railway System is commissioned successfully in a time bound manner by interfacing with the respective System Contractors.

1.15 Contract Strategy – Phase 3

- 1.15.1 The work of Signaling, Telecommunication, OHE and other systems would be done through adoption of best International practices with all the required changes to suit Indian circumstances.
- 1.15.2 The CST works for both the single line (175 km) and double line (46 km) as identified above in para 1.7.1 will be done in two Contract Packages of Design & Build Contracts.

1.16 Major Components of the work for Sahnewal-Pilkhani and Dadri-Khurja Sections of Phase - 3

1.16.1 The components of the major work for both the Contract Packages are as under:

^{*} As per Indian Railway classification for Bridges:-

(a) Important bridges are those having a linear waterway of 300 metres or a total waterway of 1000 Sq.m or more and those classified as important by the Chief Engineer / Chief Bridge Engineer, depending on considerations such as depth of waterway, extent of river training works and maintenance problems.

- (b) Major bridges are those which have a total water way of 18 linear metres or more or which has a clear opening of 12 linear metres or more in any one span.
- (c) Bridges which do not fall in these classifications are termed as minor bridges.

2. Construction Period

2.1 Construction & Defect Liability Period

2.1.1 The Construction Period of the two Contract Packages shall be 45 months and 36 months for Contract Package 301 and Contract Package 302 respectively. This will be followed by the Defect Liability Period of two years after commissioning of complete Rail system by System Contractor. The Design-Build Contractor shall be required to plan the various components of work in such a sequence that the complete work is commissioned in the required time from the date of award of contract.

3. Other Data

3.1 Hydrology

3.1.1 The project area is generally flat and is prone to water stagnation during the monsoon. Flooding is generally attributed to the high ground water table and silting of water courses coupled with rainfall intensity and low hydraulic gradients.

3.2 Climate

- 3.2.1 The climate of the project is a Tropical Monsoon Climate marked by three distinct seasons:
 - a) Summer (March-June): Hot & dry with average temperatures of 45°C sometimes reaching 47-48°C with low relative humidity (20%) and dust laden winds.
 - b) Monsoon (June-September): 85% of the average annual rainfall of 990 mm precipitates during this period and temperatures range from 40-45 °C on rainy days.
 - c) Winter (October-February): Cold with temperatures in the range of 3-4°C sometimes dropping below freezing in elevated areas. Foggy conditions can occur in some tracts.
