2.1 Maximum age should not be more than 63 years. Preference will be given to the retired employees below 62 years of age.

2.2 Remuneration will be as per DFCCIL's Policy. However, the emoluments payable to retired Govt./PSUs employees may be such that the total emoluments drawn together with the pension should not exceed the last pay drawn (basic pay + DA).
