- 3. In Clause 3.7 Part III Preamble & Instructions to Bidders Page 17, the entire work is required to be completed in all respects with 84 Months from date of issue of acceptance letter.
- 4. In Clause 10 (b) Part III Preamble & Instructions to Bidders Page 24, the Definition of Similar Nature of Work Shall be revised as under:
- (A) Definition of Similar Nature Work:



"Manufacture of complete Diesel Tower Wagon/Manufacture, installation, testing, commissioning of Main Engine & Transmission System of Diesel Tower Wagons/ Manufacture of SPART(Self Propelled Accident Relief Train or DEMU (Diesel Electric Multiple Unit).

OR

"Maintenance/Repair/Overhauling of Main Engine & Transmission System of Diesel Tower Wagon or SPART (Self Propelled Accident Relief Train or DEMU (Diesel Electric Multiple Unit)"

- (B) OEM: In terms of the Railway Board letter 2019Elect (G)/165/1 dated 22.04.2022, OEM for Tower Wagon (OEM for the work being tendered only) shall be exempted from Technical Evaluation Criteria and Financial Evaluation Criteria.
- 5. In Part VII Section II Particular Clause 5 Penalty, Liquidity Damage, the Total contractual value divided by 84 Months (instead of 36 Month) i.e. contractual value per month (Page 134).

In **Part VII Section II** Particular Clause 5 (ii), In case of any breakdown of engine/ emergency call, maintenance engineer should reach the site within 24 hrs. after receiving Fax/telephone/mobile/whatsapp message or e- mail and rectify the breakdowns due to minor cause within 48 hrs. (Page No. 133)

- Clause 4.1 Part III Preamble & Instructions to Bidders Page 19 para 1, MSE is read as Micro & small enterprises instead of Medium & Small Enterprises.
