Consultant services: Cumulative Impact Assessment (CIA) for EDFC

project

Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India Limited (DFCCIL) has applied for financing from World Bank towards the cost of the Eastern Dedicated Freight Corridor project and intends to apply part of the proceeds for engagement of consultant to carry out Cumulative Impact Assessment (CIA) and management of the suite of projects supporting the Eastern Dedicated Freight Corridor (EDFC) system of Government of India.

The objective of CIA is to inform the effects that the new EDFC will have on the modal share between the new freight corridors and the adjoining rail systems or feeder rail links. The CIA should also consider the broader impact of the new DFC on the road transport network (including impact on supply roads, origins and destinations, traffic flow, ways in which this track might impact bottlenecks elsewhere in the system). The cumulative assessment may also reveal positive effects from both the location of the line adjacent to an existing one, effects on the broader systemic transport investments (such as reducing need for investments in roadways), and climate benefits.

The Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India now invites eligible consulting firms (Consultants) to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the services. The short listing criteria are that the Consultants should have a minimum of ten years' experience in the field of Social or Environmental or Developmental Impact Assessment and should have undertaken at least one similar assignment (defined in footnote1 of Annexure 1).

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank borrowers January, 2011("Consultant Guidelines") setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

Consultant may associate with other firms in the form of a Joint Venture or a subconsultancy to enhance their qualifications.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the "Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS)" method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.

Similar assignments mean the consultancy assignment pertaining to Cumulative Impact assessment (Social/Environmental/Developmental Impact) Individual or assessment Social/Environmental/Developmental Impact of infrastructure Projects preferably linear projects like Highways, Railways, Pipeline etc. preferably funded by multilateral fundina agencies. Social/Environmental/Developmental Impact Assessment may be in same project or different projects but the consultant should have carried out all three types of Impact assessments. However, Consultants who have carried out Cumulative Impact assessment for infrastructure projects shall be preferred.
