Hon'ble Shri Mukul Roy has taken over as the new Union Railway Minister on 20th March 2012. Prior to this, Shri Roy was the Minister of State for the Ministry of Shipping since 28th May 2009 onwards. He also served earlier as Minister of State for Railways. Shri Mukul Roy was elected to Rajya Sabha in April 2006. During his

distinguished parliamentary career, Shri Roy was Member, Committee on Urban Development and Member of Consultative Committee for the Ministry of Home Affairs during August 2006 to May 2009. Shri Roy was permanent special invitee, Consultative Committee for the Ministry of Railways during April 2008 to May 2009.

#### Computerized File Tracking System introduced in DFCCIL

To infuse thrust and rapidity in decision making process in organisation, a computer based file tracking system has been assiduously developed and customised in house in record time enabling tracking and monitoring of file movement across the corporate office and will ensure that all files and their movement is accounted for. With the introduction of FTS, conventional system of file movements & registers has been done awaywith. Besides generating unique identification number for every single file, also facilitate movement of notes, office order etc.

#### Major Achievements during January - March 2012

1. Bid for Civil Structure and Track (CST) work for Bhaupur – Khurja Section (APL-1) is opened on 30.03.2012. Total 13 offers have been received. Technical Evaluation is under process.
2. Expression of interest (EOI) for PMC for Bhaupur-Khurja section has been invited and opened on 28.2.12. Evaluation of offers is in progress.
3. World Bank has approved short listing of General Consultants for Bhaupur-Mugalsari (APL-2) & Dadri-Khurja-Ludhiana (APL-3). RFP document issued and Pre-Bid conference held on 29.02.2012. Date of submission of RFP is 16th April, 2012.
4. Various Environmental Impact Assessment/ Social Impact Assessment (EIA/SIA) study required by funding agency for Eastern DFC has been completed.
5. Work on communication strategy, an actionable item in project appraisal document of the World Bank and triggers for APL-2 has also been taken up and agency is at the final stage of selection.
6. EOI for engagement of Consultancy Services for marketing strategy was submitted to World Bank on 06.02.2012 for approval / no objection. World Bank's observations received on 13.02.2012. Revised TOR and budget estimate submitted on 07.03.2012.
7. The PQ for Package – 1 & Package -2 of Ph-I has been approved by BOD and submitted to JICA for approval / No-objection. the bid document is under approval of BOD.
8. PQ for Design and Construction of Special Steel Bridges across River Mahi and Sabarmati is opened on 19.03.2012. Evaluation is under progress by Engineering Service Consultant.
9. Engineering Service Consultant (NKC-2) have submitted Global implementation schedule for Phase – II and the same has been sent to Railway Board.
10. Various EIA/SIA study required by funding agencies has been completed for Western DFC except SIA study for small portion, which is at final stage of completion.
11. STEP Components for JICA funding has been finalized and forwarded to JICA.
12. EOI for engagement of Consultancy Services for Heavy Haul Programme Development management consultant for institutional strengthening module of DFCCIL (HHPDISM) was submitted to Bank on 24.01.2012 for approval/ no objection. World Bank observations received on 13.02.2012. Accordingly, revised TOR and budget estimate sent to World Bank on 23.03.2012.
13. Revised Estimate submitted to Railway Board on 22.02.2012.
14. RITES has submitted Interim report for Preliminary Engineering cum Traffic Survey work for four future corridors viz. North – South (Delhi – Chennai), East – West (Kolkata – Mumbai), East - Coast (Kharagpur – Vijayawada) and Southern Corridor (Chennai – Goa).
15. Techno Economic Feasibility Study for Logistic Parks at Ahemdabad, Navi Mumbai and Kanpur has been taken up in hand.

**DFCCIL held interactive session with bidders of Bhaupur – Khurja CST Contract**

Pre bid conference for pre qualified (PQ) eligible bidders for CST (Civil Structure and Track) Contract for Bhaupur – Khurja section in Eastern Corridor was held in DFCCIL Corporate Office on 31.01.2012. In the interactive meet bidders' queries, doubts and clarifications were addressed by DFCCIL Management. No objection was received on 02.03.12. Response to queries and Addendum No.1 has been uploaded on website and sent to prequalified eligible bidders on 02.03.12. The technical offers have been opened on 30.03.12.



**Implementation of State of Art IT Systems in DFCCIL**

DFCCIL has awarded the contract for implementation of enterprise wide IT (Information Technology) system. The IT application which includes enterprises resource planning, geographical information system, project monitoring and management, enterprise and asset management will be implemented across DFCCIL over the next 18 months. It is worthwhile to mention award of this contract is one of the key triggers for disbursement of APL 2 (Adaptable Programme Loan) of World Bank loan. DFCCIL has completed this task ahead of schedule.

**DFCCIL organized work shop on Right to Information (RTI)**

In order to shore up the response mechanism to address people queries received under RTI act, a work shop held on 13/14 Feb 2012 in New Delhi. The comprehensive training scheduled encompassing all relevant provisions in the act was held conducted by Shri. Manahir Singh Kasana, an eminent expert in Competition Law & RTI Act and also Ex. Faculty of ISTM/DOPT. The training workshop was attended by Shri. V. K. Verma, GGM/Admn & Appellate authority, Smt. Pramila Bhargava, GM/HR and Shri. Rakesh Bhatnagar, DGM/RTI along with APIOs of Project Offices of DFCCIL.



**DFCCIL Recruited professionals through open competition**



In order to give impetus to human resource development, DFCCIL held selection through nation wide open competition to employ graduate engineers for Civil and S & T departments and further intake of Engineering Diploma holders is on the anvil. Consequently, 23 candidates selected for the post of Assistant Manager in Civil, Signal & Telecommunication stream of the organisation. New entrants joined on 19-03-2012, addressed by Managing Director, Director (Op & BD), GGM/HR, GM/HR and other officers. A comprehensive training itinerary is charted encompassing preliminary familiarisation programme in Corporate Office followed by exhaustive training at IRICEN Pune and IRISSET Secunderabad for probationers of Civil and S & T streams respectively.

MD personally discussed with each & every CPMs and monitored the progress. Amount to be spent on CSR activities as on 31.03.2012 was Rs. 20 lakhs which has already been spent and target is achieved.
