Vide reference letters above, regarding the subjected matter cited above, your request to review some provisions of RFP, review have been done by the DFCCIL and DFCCIL's remarks against each items highlighted vide above references (i) & (ii) are as under:

1. Remarks on items highlighted vide above reference -i & ii (regarding clause RFP Clause 4.1 (a): Qualifying/Eligibility Criteria)
