

2. Highlights:

a) Inauguration of Bhaupur -Khurja Section:

Hon'ble PM dedicated the 351 Km Khurja-Bhaupur section of EDFC and state of the art Operation Control Centre in Prayagraj to the nation on 29.12.2020. Hon'ble PM also flagged off long haul trains from New Khurja and New Bhaupur stations.

Maximum speed of 93 kmph & average speed of 67 kmph achieved for freight train in newly commissioned New Khurja - New Bhaupur section of EDFC. The average speed on DFC is thrice the average speed of Indian Railways freight trains. Faster transportation will reduce turnaround time and transportation cost.
