DFCCIL PROVIDES SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING UNDER ITS CSR INITIATIVE- PROJECT SAKSHAM

As part of its Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives, DFCCIL has successfully completed first phase of 'Project Saksham'. Project Saksham is an initiative of DFCCIL to empower people living along the Eastern and Western corridors under which job-oriented and skill development training is provided to PAP and BPL families to make them more competent and efficient in different fields. Under the first phase of Project Saksham, training was provided through ITI centres of Tundla and Allahabad in Eastern Corridor and Reengus, Phulera & Palghar in Western Corridor.

More than a thousand of people were trained in technical courses like Data Entry Operating, Retail Sales Associate, Electrician etc. under the program. Training Programs were started in the month of January 2016 onwards and conducted in association with Confederation of Indian Industries (CII). The next phase of Project Saksham will be started soon in other centers of the both the corridors.

DFCCIL, a special purpose vehicle (SPV) is engaged in planning, Construction, operation and maintenance of the Dedicated Freight Corridors and in the first phase, the two corridors, namely Eastern Corridor from Ludhiana to Dankuni (1840 Kms) and the Western Corridor from Dadri to Jawahar Lal Nehru Port (JNPT) (1502 Kms) are being constructed. The Western Corridors is being funded by Japan International Corporation Agency (JICA), while the Eastern Corridor from Mughalsarai to Ludhiana is being funded by the World Bank.
