Kindly direct the PIO to provide: Relevant rules/orders/circulars that apply in the scenarios mentioned in my RTI. If such rules do not exist, a certified statement to that effect. Consider this appeal for disposal under Section 19(1) and direct appropriate disclosure.</p>
