Ref: Your online Appeal application (Reg. No. DFCCL/A/E/21/00012) dated 09.05.2021.

This is in reference to your online Appeal application preferred by you against information provided to you in RTI application (Reg. No. DFCCL/R/E/21/00205) dated 01.05.2021.

Information sought vide online RTI application dated 01.05.2021 has been furnished by the CPIO on 04.05.2021 with the available information in this office. Now, you have submitted an online appeal application on the ground that information provided is incomplete and again sought information on the point no.3.

Your appeal application has been examined with due consideration. Information, which was just, to the point and as per the record available at the relevant point was provided to you. In terms of RTI Act, 2005, only the information as held on record can be provided but not clarifications or opinions. You have mentioned the clause 2(f) of RTI Act 2005, but for obvious reasons left out the Clause 2(i) of the RTI Act 2005 i.e. information in any form of material in existence and apparently, it does not have to be created. The Act does not require the PIO to do research on behalf of the citizen to deduce anything from the material and then supply to him. However, relevant Circular No. 11/2019 dated 29.05.2019 has already been provided to you.

Hope you will appreciate the position explained above.

Your appeal application thus stands disposed of.
