Text of Appeal		<p>Its constitution right of every citizen of Indian to get adequate value of their land as compensation whenever government of any authority acquires their Land. The information sought involves public interest at large as many of the land owners have not received the compensation at that time and now whenever land owners visit SLO office the land owners are itself asked by the officials to produce such documents (bank statements) which proves that they have not received the cheque of compensation for their acquired land by DFCCL. Many of the land owners had to pay bribes to middleman as to get such information. Thus I am asking the information in Public interest and for the benefits of the persons who are willing to get their compensation and its also their Constitutional right. It does not violates the privacy of any person because land was acquired by the public authority and for the benefit of the public and thus as Indian citizen have right to know thus it does not fall under the exemptions under section 8 (1) (J).</p>
