
Sub: Disposal of 1st Appeal by Shri Gurpreet Panesar

Ref: Online RTI application dated 06-05-2021 and **the online Appeal dtd 27-05-2021**

You have appealed against non- satisfactory reply. The appeal as referred to above has been given due consideration and the following comments are offered;

1. As per section 105(3) of RFCT-LARR 2013, any provisions of this act do not reduce the compensation or dilute the provisions of this Act relating to compensation or rehabilitation and settlement. DFCCIL/Railway is acquiring land as per this Act by Concerned District revenue officers that Compensation and RR benefits have not been reduced. And as per joint reading of section 105(1) and fourth schedule of RFCT-LARR Act 2013, and RTI Act 2005, the information sought by the Applicant as cited wrong provision of law. Therefore, the department is not obliged to provide information as per law.
2. In this point information sought by you cannot be provided as per law.
- 3,5 & 6. That the process of acquisition of land for public purposes differs in different laws as enacted by the parliament. Therefore, you should be specific in seeking information under the correct laws. Any casual information by citing wrong provision of law, the department is not supposed to provide the information under the RTI Act 2005.
4. No information has been hidden or diluted.
- 7, 8. No such information is available in this office.
- 8 & 9. No information is sought here.
