Reference: Your online RTI application dated 25.05.2021 (Registration No DFCCL/R/E/21/00287) received through DOPT.

In reference to your RTI application dated 25.05.2021, you were advised through DOPT portal on 26.05.2021 to deposit Rs. 36/- as stationery charges either through DOPT portal or by IPO (Indian Postal Order)/Demand Draft/ Bankers' Cheque in favour of DFCCIL, New Delhi within 60 days for providing information sought by you. However, after a lapse of more than 45 days time, you have still not deposited the stationery charges. In this regard a reminder mail was also sent to you on 30.06.2021. It seems that you are not interested in getting information. As such, information on other points, for which no stationery charges is required, is as under:-

In case DFCCIL does not receive the payment or any such proof of payment by you within 60 days period from the date of receipt of this letter, the case will be closed presuming that you are no more interested for getting the information.

Hope the above information is complete and satisfactory. If not, then you can appeal within 30 days of receipt of the letter to the 1st Appellate Authority whose name and address is as under;
