



- b) In terms of SCC Sub Clause No-2.4, the estimated duration of Consultancy Services to DFCCIL (Part-A) shall be for a period of 06 Years (including 04 years of Construction period plus 02 years of Defect Notification period) and duration of Consultancy Services to MOR (Part-B) for Contract Package RS P-7 shall be 96 months.
