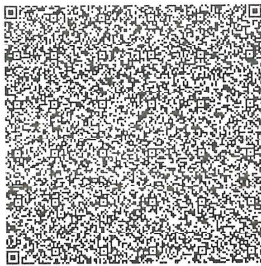

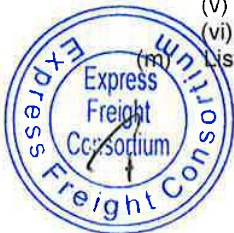

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### I. Contract Agreement No. HQ/EN/PWC/PMC-2R

This CONTRACT (hereinafter called the "Contract") is made the 21<sup>st</sup> day of the month of March 2016, between, on the one hand, Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India Limited (DFCCIL)(hereinafter called the "Client") and, on the other hand, OCG Consortium (hereinafter called the "Consultant") consisting of the following entities, each of which will be jointly and severally liable to the Client for all the Consultant's obligations under this Contract, namely, Oriental Consultants Global Co. Ltd., Japan, Oriental Consultants India Pvt. Ltd., Nippon Koei Co. Ltd., Nippon Koei India Pvt. Ltd. And RITES Ltd. (hereinafter collectively called the "Consultant").



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2. The onus of checking the legitimacy is on the users of the certificate.
3. In case of any discrepancy please inform the Competent Authority.



## WHEREAS

- a) The Client has requested the Consultant to provide Project Consultancy Services for (A) Construction of Double Line Electrified Railway Track with Signaling & Telecommunication system and related infrastructure for Rewari-Dadri & JNPT-Vadodara section (approximately 555 route km) of Phase-2 of Western Dedicated freight Corridor and (B) procurement of electric locomotives as defined in this Contract (hereinafter called the "Services");
- b) In terms of SCC Sub Clause No-2.4, the estimated duration of Consultancy Services to DFCCIL (Part-A) shall be for a period of 06 Years ( including 04 years of Construction period plus 02 years of Defect Notification period) and duration of Consultancy Services to MOR (Part-B) for Contract Package RS P-7 shall be 96 months.
- c) The Consultant, having represented to the Client that it has the required professional skills, and personnel and technical resources, has agreed to provide the Services on the terms and conditions set forth in this Contract;
- d) By an Agreement dated Twenty-Eight March, Two Thousand Thirteen (28-03-2013) (hereinafter called the Loan Agreement) between the DFCCIL through Ministry of Railways (MOR), Government of India (hereinafter called the Borrower) and Japan International Cooperation Agency (hereinafter called JICA), JICA has agreed to make a loan to the Borrower for the purpose of financing Construction of Western Dedicated Freight Corridor Phase 2(R) between Rewari - Dadri and JNPT-Vadodara (hereinafter called the Project) and for aforesaid Consultancy services;

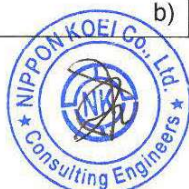
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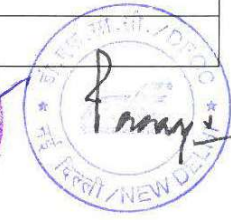


