Standard deviation and Mean Value along with the raw marks of a candidate is required for calculating T-score:		
a)	What is the Mean Value score for each and every section, that has been used to calculate the T-score in the CBAT exam conducted for the Executive post of OP & BD which took place on 22-March-2024.	Information sought cannot be provided as per the order passed by Hon'ble High Court, Delhi in W.P.C. No. 2173 of 2013 CM 4120/2013 dated 21.11.2014 (Ministry of Railways Vs. K.G. Arun Kumar) it was clearly mentioned that Psychological tests (Aptitude Test) are designed to test the mental aptitude for safety category staff necessary for safety on the Indian Railways and same aptitude test papers are reused in the future examination. Any exposure of the aptitude test and answer key to the applicant would be tantamount to leakage of the answer key of the aptitude test, which could be misutilised rendering future selection almost impossible.
b)	What is the Standard Deviation score for each and every section, that has been used to calculate the T-score in the CBAT exam conducted for the Executive post of OP & BD which took place on 22-March-2024.
