There have been some delay on account of acquisition of land, resistance by PAPs in handing over acquired land, construction of ROBs/RUBs, inability of the contractor to mobilize required manpower and material. However, all efforts are being made to complete the work as planned.<br><b>WDFC:</b> The works got delayed during Financial Year 2019-20 because of the worldwide pandemic situation due to spread of COVID-19 resulting in:<br>(i) Disruption in supply chain of construction materials due to Lockdown.<br>(ii) Migration of labour to their home town.<br>(iii) Reduction in productivity of resources/labour due to social distancing norms. |
