
The undersigned in the capacity of Appellate Authority has gone through the above appeal and found that the appellant has expressed his dissatisfaction over our reply dated 27-11-2017 in response to his RTI application dated 17-08-2017.

The applicant, vide his RTI application, has mainly sought for information with respect to the details of officials nominated for material inspection at Japan, the inspection report and the related documents concerning the inspection.

The deemed CPIO had not provided the details as asked for saying those are personal and third party information. However, all the details have been received from the deemed CPIO and it is seen that the information is voluminous. Sending all the booklets which are 16 in number and contains $1672 + 30 = 1702$ pages calls for making huge number of photocopies and to make another 16 booklets for office copy involving significant exercises/expenses.

In this circumstances, it is advised that the appellant may visit our office at any working day and inspect all the papers/information collated/collected from the third party and choose/select the paper/s which exactly he wants to have. The papers will be provided to him free of cost then and there. However, certain papers containing the information sought for and as received from the deemed CPIO are sent herewith.

Cooperation from the appellant side is solicited.
