Sub: Disposal of Appeal under RTI Act-2005

**Ref: Your Appeal dated 12.10.2017 received through the DOPT portal vide Regd.
No. DFCCIL/R/2017/60007.**

Your appeal dated 12-10-2017 have gone through wherein, you have asked for response from Dir/Infra in respect of your complaint addressed to CVO/DFCCIL and you have stated that neither DIR/infra nor his office has responded to your complaint.

Secondly, you have raised questions over the reply of PIO- *"that the matter doesn't concern to Vigilance Department of DFCCIL"*. You have also cited there that you have made as many as 05 e-mails against inappropriate conduct of DFCCIL employees which is the concern of CVO/DFCCIL. Then you have cited your references on yours complaints at various levels including filing of FIR at police stations, stoppage of your salary etc. which DFCCIL doesn't concern with.

It is found that you have deviated from the original points on which you had sought for information i.e, status of your complaint to CVO/DFCCIL and very rightly you have been provided with the status of your complaint by the CPIO vide his letter dated 08-09-2017. Whereas, in the appeal you have asked for the action on your complaint that too from the authority other than to whom such complaint was made by you.

In view of the above and your appeal being more of a representation seeking action can't be dealt with under the RTI Act.2005. However, the reply given to you vide CPIO's letter dated 08-09-2017 being just and complete and as such the instant appeal is disposed of holding the same good.
