- 1 Ministry of Railways, Government of India have planned to construct Dedicated Freight Corridor (DFC) covering about 2762 route kms along two alignments, Eastern Corridor from Ludhiana to Sonenagar/ Dankuni and Western Corridor from Jawaharlal Nehru Port, Mumbai to Tughlakabad/ Dadri along with inter-linking of two corridors at Khurja. The Project entails construction of mostly double track railway lines capable of handling 32.5 tonne axle load, longer trains and also double stack container trains. Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India Limited (DFCC) is a Government of India Enterprise setup for implementation of the DFC Project. Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India Limited, Palika Bhavan, Sector- XIII, R.K.Puram, New Delhi invites bids for Design and Build single stage two packet system for the following work, on lump sum basis, from the experienced Contractors having relevant experience and fulfilling other eligibility and qualification criteria.

The work of Design and Build Lump sum contract consists of Design and Construction of Important and Major bridges between Vaitarna and Utran on Western Corridor. The bridges shall be for double track. Vaitarna to Utran section falls between Mumbai Central and Vadodara Main Line of Western Railway.

- 2 The bid documents shall be available for sale at the office of the GGM/Engg/I, DFCC, 7<sup>th</sup> Floor, Palika Bhavan, Sector- XIII, R.K.Puram, New Delhi-110066 from 15.07.2008 to 03.09.2008 during 11.00 hrs. to 17.00 hrs on working days and can be purchased by interested bidders on submission of a written request to the address given above along with payment of Rs. 50,000/- (non-refundable) in the form of DD or Banker's cheque from any Nationalised or Scheduled Bank of India in favour of Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India Ltd, NewDelhi.

- 3 Bidding documents requested by Post will be dispatched by registered speed post/courier on payment of an extra amount of **Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only)**.
- 4 Bidding Documents as well as the various drawings can also be downloaded from DFCC website **www.dfcc.in** and **www.dfccil.org** from **11.07.08**. The bids can be submitted on the down loaded document along with demand draft towards the cost of bidding documents kept in a separate envelope marked “Cost of Bidding Documents”. The offer will be summarily rejected if cost of bidding documents is not enclosed for bids downloaded from web site.

The bid documents also contain drawings. The cost of such drawings is included in the cost of bid documents. If difficulty is being faced by prospective bidders in downloading the drawings the bidder can contact office of GGM/Engg I, DFCC on any working day to view the drawings and if required obtain a copy of the same in the form of CD. It will be the responsibility of the bidder who is submitting the bid on downloaded bidding documents to check the correctness of these documents and also check the DFCC website from time to time till bid due date for any addendum/Corrigendum issued in regard to this bid to ensure submission of bid along with all addendum/Corrigendum.

- 5 **Eligibility and Qualification Criteria** – A bidder single or a Joint venture (of not more than three members) who are authorized to do business or have permission to do business in India as per Indian laws are eligible to bid individually or as a member of JV. The Minimum Eligibility Criteria to be satisfied by the bidders has been given in the tender Documents. Bidders are advised go through the eligibility criteria given in the tender documents. Important parameters are briefly given as under

5.1 **Financial** – The Single bidder or Joint Venture–

(a) shall have received contractual payment from infrastructure works completed or in progress, of **not less than Rs. 800 crores**, during last five financial years i.e. 2003-04, 2004-05, 2005 -06, 2006-07, 2007-08 and upto the date of opening of Bid, and

(b) shall have a minimum net worth of Rs.60 Cr. in each of the last three financial years i.e. 2005 -06, 2006-07, 2007-08. In case of Joint Venture Lead member of the Joint venture should satisfy this requirement.

5.2 **Technical** – A Single bidder<sup>S</sup> or lead member of a Joint Venture should have following technical qualifications:

- a) Should have experience of Infrastructure works \* and must have successfully completed /substantially \*\* completed during last 5 (five ) years (2003-04 to 2007-08) and upto application submission date at least

**One contract of value not less than Rs 150 Crore**

**And**

- b) Successfully completed /substantially\*\* completed during last 5 (five) years (2003-04 to 2007-08) upto application submission date, works of prestressed concrete structures for rivers/canals/creeks crossings, elevated metro corridors and expressways at least

**One Contract of value not less than Rs 75 Crore OR Two contracts each of value not less than Rs 50 Crore**

Note

- a) *\*The Infrastructure works to be considered would be works of Highways, Expressways Tunnels, Dam projects, Airports, Sea ports, Railways (new lines, doublings, Gauge Conversion and Bridge works)*
- b) *\*\* Substantially completed work would be one in which 80 % satisfactorily completion has been done and the value of such completed portion should be not less than as specified in the column for Requirements. The work should be certified by the client for whom these works are being done.*
- c) *§In case of an existing JV as bidder, the Technical criteria may be satisfied by the JV or its lead member.*

6 Bids shall be submitted to the **GGM/Engg/I, Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India Ltd., Room No. 703, 7<sup>th</sup> Floor, Palika Bhawan, Sector-XIII, R.K.Puram, New Delhi-110066** on or before **04.09.08** up to **15.00 hrs.**

- 6.1 Bids shall remain valid for period of **120 days** from the date of submission of bid.
- 6.2 Right to reject any or all bid(s) without assigning any reason thereof is reserved with DFCC.
- 6.3 The Technical bids shall be opened on the same day at **15:30 hrs.**
- 6.4 Bids must be accompanied by a bid security of **Rs 4.19 Crore (Rupees four point one nine Crores only)** in any one of the forms as specified in the bidding documents and shall have to be valid for 45 days beyond the validity of the bid. Out of Rs. 4.19 Crore, Rs. 1 Crore (INR) should be submitted in the shape of a FDR (Fixed deposit receipt) or Banker's Cheque and the rest of the amount in the shape of Bank Guarantee from Nationalized /Scheduled Indian Bank.
- 6.5 Bids received late will be rejected.

7 Pre- Bid meeting will be held on **28<sup>th</sup> July, 2008** at **11.00 hrs** in **Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India limited, Conference Room, 4<sup>th</sup> floor, Palika Bhawan, sector XIII, R K Puram, New Delhi 110066, India.**

- 7.1 Authorised Representatives of only those bidders would be permitted to attend the Pre-bid meeting who have purchased the tender document or deposited the cost of bidding document in the form of Demand Draft or Banker's cheque in favour of DFCC on the day of pre-bid meeting before start of the meeting.
- 7.2 The prospective bidders are required to send following details to DFCC through email or fax (contact details given at para 8 below)-

- iii. Name(s) of the person(s) attending the pre-bid meeting
