Message

World Environment Day was established by the United Nations General Assembly in 1972 to mark the day on which United Nations Conference on the Human Environment began. Since then, every year the Day is observed on 5th June Globally under the aegis of United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP). This year World Environment Day theme is "Seven Billion Dreams. One Planet. Consume with Care." The theme focusses on responsible management of of the planet's resources because far more natural resources are being consumed than what the planet can sustainably provide.
